Third went to Lew Nightingale from fancied end peg 21 who did not fare so well with silver fish or Carp unfortunately losing four Carp, one right on the final whistle having either his hook trace broken or losing the lot. He did manage to land one which weighed 9 11 0 he fished yellow wafter all day on the method feeder, and he finished with just under 11 0 0.
