Decoy fished very well despite the water level being about two feet below the normal level, due to the low level the net limit was reduced to 30 0 0 with a 5 0 0 margin. Tim Brightey fell fowl of the net limit on two of his nets and was duly knocked back to the 30 0 0 limit, he also had to tip back five skimmers to free up his third net for more Carp, despite this he still put 81 0 0 on the scales from peg 32 for the win. He started on the method feeder and wafters before switching to the pole and paste down to the pads. Darren Chilcott fishing on peg 28 came second with 66 13 0, he also started on the method feeder before turning to the pellet waggler and picking up a couple of Carp and he finished with a flourish down the margin on

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the pole and paste. Third went to Stewart Morton on peg 13 unfortunately he also exceeded the net limit by a couple of pounds on one of his nets which cost him second by ounces. He finished with 66 8 0 fishing the method feeder and wafers. The biggest loser on day was Steve Pead who had one of his nets disqualified due to being four ounces over the upper net limit which would have made a big difference to the top three, lesson to be learned.
